On 1^{st} and 2^{nd} June 2024, two interns of M.A Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy and Research were assigned as on-field physiotherapists for a football tournament conducted by St. Vincent High School, Pune. On first day of tournament, interns provided immediate first aid to the players who suffered from ankle sprains, muscle strains etc where primary line of treatment given was application on R.I.C.E principle i.e rest, icing, elevation, compression and few stretches were also given. Throughout the tournament many injuries were treated by the interns. On 2nd day, similar injuries were treated however during knockout match, a player sustained tibial fracture. The interns rushed and provided immediate temporary support to the leg and ambulance was called to take the player to hospital for immediate care. The player was referred to Dr. Shoaib Shaikh, an orthopedic surgeon from Modern Hospital, Nana Peth where further management would be carried out.
