EVENT- PHYSIOTHERAPY SERVICES FOR THE WARKARI COMMUNITY.

A physiotherapy camp was conducted on 21st June 2025 (Saturday) at Kasba Ganpati Mandir, Kasba Peth, Pune, for the Warkari community. The camp was organized under the guidance of Hon'ble Chief Minister Mr. Devendra Fadnavis and aimed at providing free physiotherapy services to the Warkaris.

A team comprising 2 faculty members, 5 interns, and 22 final year students from M.A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy and Research actively participated in the camp. The physiotherapy services were rendered under the supervision of Dr. Hiba Memon and Dr. Sayali Bhalge. The camp was held from 9:00 AM to 5:30 PM, during which a total of 129 Warkaris were clinically assessed and treated. The treatment protocols included therapeutic exercises and electrotherapy modalities such as Interferential Therapy (IFT), Transcutaneous Electrical Nerve Stimulation (TENS), Infrared Radiation (IRR).

The camp successfully addressed musculoskeletal complaints commonly experienced by the Warkari pilgrims due to prolonged walking and physical exertion. The organizing committee, representing the office of the Chief Minister, also visited the camp site and appreciated the efforts of the physiotherapy team.
