1. On 10th January 2025, staff of M. A. Rangoonwala college of Physiotherapy and research attended online LIC Inspection workshop organized by MUHS Nashik to gain insights on the right method of conducting LIC Inspection.
2. On 13th and 14th January 2025, MPT students attended Resident as a teacher Teaching technology (MET) workshop at Kashibai Navale college of Physiotherapy, Pune to improve knowledge on various Teaching Learning methods that can be useful.
3. On 25th January 2025, 1st year students attended a session on Mental Health by Dr. Tauleha Bukhari, Asst. Professor Z.V.M Unani Medical College. This session helped students to understand various coping methods to adapt especially to overcome their new journey in a professional course and learn about ways to deal with mentally challenging situations.
4. From 29th to 31st January 2025, PG students provided Physiotherapy support to Intra-college sports event by Allana College of Architecture which included Cricket, Kabaddi and Athletics. Postgraduate students got hands on experience in tacking on field sport specific injuries as physiotherapists.
5. On 30th January 2025, students attended a Free NSS Rural camp at Zilla Parishad Prathamik Shala, Wadgaon organized by A.K.K Law academy where they gave physiotherapy services to 40 patients. Students learning techniques of treating patients in community set ups, give home protocols and give group exercises.
6. From 3rd to 8th February 2025, MPT students attended Faculty Development Program for enhancing Research skills and improve knowledge on new developments in research methodology. It was organized by M. A. Rangoonwala Institute of Hotel Management.
7. On 4th March 2025, Dr. Pooja. Kesharwani delivered a lecture to M. A. Psychology students of Abeda Inamdar Senior college students on Health, Disability and Rehabilitation.

8. On 7th March 2025, Dr. Pooja. Kesharwani was invited for a guest lecture at Allana Pharmacy College for seminar on Ergonomics for Women.
9. On 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025, awareness program was organized for 4<sup>th</sup> year students of M. A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy for World Down's Syndrome Day. An introductory lecture was given by Dr. Rebecca followed by a documentary presentation showing the life of these individuals. It was a very different yet enriching learning experience for the students.
10. On 21<sup>st</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> April 2025, a guest lecture was organized for the students of Final year BPTTh on topic of Urinary Incontinence. Resource person for the lecture was Dr. Smita Shinde, Asso Professor from D. Y. Patil College of Physiotherapy, Pune.
11. On 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> April 2025, Dr. Ronika Agrawal along with 3 staff attended the TOT Workshop on Implementation of new 'Competency Based Physiotherapy Curriculum' from 1<sup>st</sup> year BPT students. It was organized at Suryadutta Institute of Health Sciences, Bavdhan.

On 16<sup>th</sup> May 2025, an Alumni activity was conducted for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year students along with MPT's where college alumni Dr. Muizz Shaikh delivered a guest lecture on a recent advanced technology in physiotherapy treatment called 'Frequency Specific Microcurrents'. Students were very happy to discover about this new electrotherapy modality.
13. On 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> June 2025, Interns of M. A. Rangoonwala College of Physiotherapy gave physiotherapy services at St. Vincent Sports event where many players were given on field treatment.
14. On 12<sup>th</sup> June 2025, World Environment Day was celebrated in college with an awareness program where students used waste materials for making useful household items. Staff and students learned about way for protection of environment and various sustainable practices to be adapted were promoted.
15. On 21<sup>st</sup> June 2025, 4<sup>th</sup> year Students along with staff Dr. Hiba and Dr. Sayali gave physiotherapy services to warkaris at Kasba peth organized by CMO. 129 warkaris benefitted from this camp. Students learned about selfless service for the benefit of warkaris.
16. On 21<sup>st</sup> June 2025, International Yoga Day was celebrated in college where Dr. Jennifer gave a short introduction and history about Yoga and took a yoga session for staff and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students. Students enthusiastically participated in this session. They could apply and associate their knowledge of Yoga learned in 1<sup>st</sup> year.

17. On 24<sup>th</sup> June 2025, a program was organized for Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan initiative where 4<sup>th</sup> year students gave a presentation on the effects of addictions, 3<sup>rd</sup> year students took oath, 2<sup>nd</sup> year students performed a skit on the topic and 1<sup>st</sup> year students did poster presentation on say no to drugs.
18. On 25<sup>th</sup> June 2025, staff Dr. Hiba and Dr. Sneha along with 4<sup>th</sup> year students, provided physiotherapy services at Valhe camp to the warkaris. It was organized by CMO where 139 patients were treated. Students learned about selfless service for the benefit of warkaris.
19. On 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2025, Anti ragging awareness program was held in college with a debate competition. This event aimed to create awareness amongst students about harmful effects of ragging and promote safe and respectful campus environment.
20. On 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2025, Dr. Ronika Agrawal and Dr. Pooja G attended a webinar on Digital Health Foundation Course organized by MUHS.
21. On 5<sup>th</sup> July 2025, Dr. Ronika Agrawal was felicitated at the hands of Hon. CM Mr. Devendra Fadnavis in Pandharpur for rendering PT services to warkaris under Charanseva.
22. On 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2025, staff and students participated in Rural camp at Narayangaon organized by CMO. Total 101 patients were treated in this camp. Students got exposure on community based physiotherapy assessment and rehabilitation.
23. On 7<sup>th</sup> August 2025, Dr. Hiba and Dr. Sanaa along with final year BPT students visited MAHER old age home for a visit. Students gave various donations to the inmates there as per their requirement. Students learned about various health issues of old individuals from community point of view.
24. On 20<sup>th</sup> August 2025, a Guest Lecture was arranged for 3<sup>rd</sup> year, 4<sup>th</sup> year and MPT students on Overseas opportunities and education from M. B. Patil Education Pvt Ltd, Pune. The instructors for the session were Anuja Pawar (Overseas education head) and Rameshwar Gagrani.
25. On 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2025, Dr. Sneha along with 4<sup>th</sup> Year students actively participated in Maha Arogya Shibir At Vadaj, Junnar, providing a detailed assessment and treatment at the camp stations. Total of 186 patients benefitted from this camp.
26. On 16<sup>th</sup> September 2025, Dr. Hiba and Dr. Sanaa, along with final year students, went for an Industrial visit at SUS Garment Industry- Wakad. Students learned a lot about various aspects of Industrial/occupational health in this industry.
